In the morning put a small piece of lard in a frying pan, and pour in a pint of milk. When it is warm then add the yeast: make it into a sponge; when light make it only moderately stiff with flour; let it rise again, well out, and cut into round cakes; fold one side partly over the other, greasing between with butter melted, and when light again bake for twenty minutes.

CREAM PIE.—The yolks of two eggs, two-thirds of a cup of sugar, one-half cup flour and one pint sweet milk. Mix the eggs, flour and sugar thoroughly, and stir into the milk when it boils; flavour with lemon. Bake a pie crust, pour the mixture into it, and place it in the oven for fitteen minutes. Beat the whites of the eggs tho roughly, and mix with two tablespoonfuls of sugar; place it over the top of the pie, and set in a hot oven till lightly browned.




