A GOOD SUGGESTION.

A GOOD SUGGESTION.

A very good suggestion in the interests of the travelling fraternity was obtained this week by a Commercial man in an interview with Secretary Cox, of the Northwest Commercial Travellers' Association, and we take the liberty of passing it along in the hope that the idea will be taken up and put to use by the parties who are concerned. It is briefly that the office of the travellers' association be made more use of by wholesale houses and in fact by all concerns, which employ travelling salesmen as a sort of a bureau through which suitable men may be obtained to fill vacancies which occur from time to time on the travelling staff of the house. It is often the case that good houses are in want of a traveller and have no one available in the other departments of their service to fill the vacancy. They do not care to advertise publicly for a man and the result is perhaps delay in securing a sultable person. In nearly every case if the secretary of the travelers association were to be consulted the best available man could be obtained without any trouble or expense for advertising.
