TORONTO, Feb., 25th, 1880.

Not very much can be said positively about the improvement of business since our last report but relatively it is better. Wholesale houses in most instances state that sales are satisfactory and that indications are very promising. Already the dry goods houses are busy, orders from travellers coming in briskly and the outlook is decidedly hopeful. The same may be said of the hardware and grocery trades. Since last sennight the position has changed much for the better in the grain trade owing to advancing English and American values, prices for flour have hardened considerably and values of grain have advanced from 3 to 5 cents. In the stock market prices have been fairly maintained though transactions have not been large.

DRY GOODS.—Travellers are sending in orders freely and business prospects are quite promising.

ing. FLOUR.—Stocks in store 15,599 bbls., against 15,740 bbls., last week and 23,279 bbls., on like date last year. Since last sennight the market has strengthened and values are from 10 to 15c, enhanced. There has been rather more enquiry and holders, though willing to sell are firm in their demands sales are still for consumption, quotations are for superior \$5.90 to 6. Extra \$5.75 to 5.80; Strong Bakers \$5.70 to 5.75; Spring Extra \$5.55 to 5.60. Oatmeal is unheeded at quotations.

GRAIN.—Wheat.—Fall.—Stocks in store 153,-939 bush., against 173,385 bush., last week and 83,370 bush., on like date last year. In sympathy with English and American markets prices have improved and the demand has been active, but market closes with more disposition to sell than to buy.
