

(c) Any notification of accession under paragraph (a) of this Article may include any dependency or mandated territory administered by the Government of the country in respect of which such notification of accession is given; and any notice of termination in respect of any such country under paragraph (b) shall apply to any dependency or mandated territory which was included in the notification of accession in respect of that country.

In witness whereof the undersigned have signed the present Convention, in English and Spanish, and have affixed thereto their seals.

(a) Such notification shall state the territories in the territory concerned to whom request for accession is made. The date of such notification shall be one month from the date of such notification.

(b) Either of the High Contracting Parties may at any time after the expiry of three years from the coming into force of an extension of this Convention to any of the territories referred to in paragraph (a) of this Article terminate such extension by giving six months' notice of termination through the diplomatic channel.

(c) The termination of the Convention under Article 15 shall, unless otherwise expressly agreed to by both High Contracting Parties, ipso facto terminate in respect of any territories to which it has been extended under paragraph (a) of this Article.

Security for Costa

Article 17

(a) The provisions of paragraph (a) of Article 16 shall apply to any such notification given through the Ambassador in London.

Article 18

(a) His Britannic Majesty may at any time, while the present Convention is in force, either under Article 15 or by virtue of any accession under this Article, by a notification given as aforesaid through the diplomatic channel to the present Convention in respect of any of his self-governing territories or India, provided that no notification of accession may be given at any time when His Britannic Majesty has given notice of termination in respect of all the territories of His Britannic Majesty.

(b) After the expiry of three years from the date of any accession under paragraph (a) of this Article, His Britannic Majesty may, by giving six months' notice of termination through the diplomatic channel, terminate the application of the Convention to any country in respect of which a notification of accession has been given.
