- RESULTS OF INVESTIGATIONS
engagement on the following occasions
Commissioner of Police and other
officials on the occasion of the
village assembly in the following
order: (a) The presence of
the three investigations ordered on
these complaints showed the following:
- a). LUANG PRABANG:
- The allegations could not be investigated
because the local Laotian National Army
Commander and Royal Lao Civil Government and
civil authorities failed to produce
witnesses despite repeated efforts of the
team.
- b). XIENG KHOUANG:
- (i) Four persons belonging to Xieng Khouang
Province left their villages against
their will in the company of People's
Volunteers of Vietnam/Pathet Lao forces
in July 1954, that is, before the
Geneva Agreement came into force;
whilst in Sam Neua according to the
statements made, these men were given
uniforms, ammunition and arms.
