

ARTICLE VIII

The financial costs and managerial efforts required to implement the cooperative activities listed in Article IV shall be borne by the two Governments according to the principle of shared responsibilities.

ARTICLE IX

This Agreement shall be implemented mainly through sectoral understandings or subsidiary arrangements that shall describe, for one or more sectors:

- (a) The objectives, specific action programs and technical conditions for implementation;
- (b) The conditions for the allocation of various types of activities as listed in Article IV;
- (c) Where applicable, the financing of said activities, including the possibility of conducting some of them on a cost recovery basis;
- (d) Whatever other administrative conditions may be required for their establishment.

ARTICLE X

The cooperative activities may be conducted through the intervention of various executive agencies which, after obtaining the approval of the Parties to this Agreement, may themselves conclude subsidiary arrangements.

ARTICLE XI

The administrative and financial provisions governing the recruitment and secondment of experts and the status of students and trainees shall be determined by subsequent understanding applicable to all implementation arrangements under this Agreement, and by other terms and conditions to be determined by common consent.

ARTICLE XII

- (a) The scientific and technical cooperation requirements of either Party shall be put forward when the Joint Commission meets;
- (b) Within the framework of the work of the Joint Commission, and to ensure coordination in the implementation of its activities, an Intergovernmental Working Group on Scientific and Technical Cooperation is instituted and it shall meet as required at a time mutually agreed upon by the Parties.

This Intergovernmental Working Group for Scientific and Technical Cooperation shall be responsible for:

- determining, on the basis of the decisions and policies of the Joint Commission, the terms and conditions governing implementation of the scientific and technical cooperation activities, and seeing that they are carried out properly;
