1. The Parties shall, in the exercise of their respective powers, ensure that the operation of the agreed services on the specified routes set out in the Schedule of Routes attached as an integral part of this Agreement shall be subject to the following conditions:

(a) to put down and take on in the territory of Greece international passengers, mail and cargo destined for and coming from Canada;

(b) to carry international traffic in passengers, mail and cargo between Canada and intermediate points;

(c) to carry traffic and out of the territory of Greece in direct transit through international airports situated in or destined for points in third countries specified in the Schedule of Routes;

(d) to grant on any of all flights, any one of the immediate points

Government shall have the following rights:

(a) to put down and take on in the territory of Canada international traffic in passengers, mail and cargo destined for and coming from Greece;

(b) to carry international traffic in passengers, mail and cargo between Greece and intermediate points;

(c) to carry traffic and out of the territory of Canada, in direct transit through international airports situated in or destined for points in third countries specified in the Schedule of Routes;

(d) to grant on any of all flights, any one of the immediate points

Nothing in this Agreement shall be deemed to confer on an airline of one Contracting Party the privilege to take on in the territory of the other Contracting Party passengers, mail and cargo destined for and coming from the territory of the other Contracting Party.
