

Government of Dominica is not able to provide accommodation; and

- (vii) subject to paragraph 1(b) of Annex "B" of this Agreement, where the assignment of said personnel is less than six (6) months, the cost for temporary accommodation.
- (c) Expenditures related to certain projects:
- (i) the cost of services of engineers, architects, and other experts required for the planning and execution of projects; and
 - (ii) the cost of providing materials, equipment, supplies, and other goods, and of the transportation of same to the port of entry in Dominica.
- II. Contracts for the purchase of goods and services required in connection with projects, and agreed to be financed by the Government of Canada, shall be signed by the Government of Canada, or one of its agencies. However, it may be provided in subsidiary arrangements or loan agreements entered into pursuant to this Agreement, that such contracts shall be signed by the Government of Dominica, or one of its agencies, in accordance with the terms and conditions specified in said subsidiary arrangements or loan agreements, consistent with Government of Canada practices.
- III. The Government of Canada shall provide the Government of Dominica with the names of the Canadian personnel and their dependents entitled to the rights and privileges set forth in this Agreement, in subsidiary arrangements or loan agreements.
