EDUCATION.

The following extracts from the twenty-first annual report of the Superintendent of Education for 1892, shows not only a large increase in enrollment and average attendance at the schools during the year, but that the progress made was also satisfactory, and gratifying.

The number of schools in operation was 149, as follows: High schools, 4; Graded schools, 14; Ward schools, 7; Rural schools, 124.

The number of teachers and monitors employed was 228, an increase of 48 over that for the previous year.

The whole number of pupils enrolled during the year was 10,773 an increase 1,513 over that for the previous year, and the average actual daily attendance was 6,227.10 an increase of 1,092.19 for the same period.

The total expenditure by the Lands and Works Department for the construction of school houses, furniture, repairs and improvements was \$47,192.58.

The total expenditure for all purposes of education during the year was \$178,378.53.

During the past year school houses were erected, or additions made to school buildings in twenty-eight districts.

At the present time schools are in operation in eleven newly created districts.
