BRETHREN,

I T is not unknown to fome of you, that I came laft October into thefe parts upon no other occasion than to view the Fronteers, and put them into the best posture I could, to fecure us and you, from the Attempts of the French, and their Indians, our Enemies and yours. And in order to this, I fent a fupply of Ammunition, Artillery, and Christian Souldiers, fufficient to prevent any Infult from our Enemies, and it had the effect I expected, for they durft not face the
