It undertakes to place a siding and a station at Orillia, and to provide a siding at the foot of all streets running into the lake. The town agrees to give a bonus of \$20,000, in 4 per cent. debentures, instead of cash; to supply power, light and water for the purpose of the town, and to provide a right of way 66 feet wide through Orillia, and to provide a right of way 100 feet wide through the town's factory site, including five acres of said site, on certain conditions. The town is to assist the James Bay Railway Company in getting a right of way along the lake front outside the Grand Trunk water lots. The company asked for exemption from taxation, but this was refused. They requested the request on condition that Orillia be made a division point, but the council refused to be bound to any such agreement. The company promised to indemnify the boat-house owners, but refused to include a provision to this effect. A by-law confirming the ratification of the agreement about May 15. There is no doubt that the by-law will carry, as the feeling is strong in favor of the railway.

MAIN FORCE REACHES KIRIN. REAR GUARD STILL FIGHTING

"Enemy in Retreating Towards Hailung Fought at Every Step" is Report to Tokio.

Tokio, April 14.—The following official announcement was made to-day: "Our force advancing eastward via Fushan and Hailung-road encountered and defeated the enemy on the morning of the 12th at Erhshu, seven miles east of Yingpan. The enemy's strength was one regiment of infantry, six squadrons of cavalry and four guns. Our force, then occupied Tsangshin, about 18 miles west of Yingpan. The enemy, in retreating towards Hailung, fought every step."

The enemy on the Kirin-road has gradually retreated since the eleventh a portion of this force still remaining to bar the passage of the Tushu River.

"No change has occurred in the Chuangchi or Fushan districts, except occasional 'Walay' skirmishes."

Main Force at Kirin. It is reported that the main force of the Russians, which retired in the direction of Hailung, has reached Kirin. The rear guard, which is estimated at 12,000 men, continues in the vicinity of Hailungcheng, closely in touch with the Japanese vanguard.

The main force, which retired from Kailuan, over the Kirin-road, is reported at Kirin, with a rear guard of 800 men at Hailung, Hailuan and Hailung, keeping in touch with the Japanese forces.

Changchen is evidently the rallying point for the Russian forces. Altogether, a force, estimated at 23,000 men has been detailed to occupy Fushan and Hailung, and to hold Fushan, the latter force seems assigned to check and retard the Japanese advance.

In State of Siege. The imperial ordinance which declared Hailung Harbor, on the Pootchodors Islands, in a state of siege, becomes operative to-day.
