Tokio, April 14.—The following official mouncement was made to-day: "Our force advancing eastward via Fushun feated the enemy on the morning of the 12th at Erhhousu, seven miles east of Yingpan. The enemy's strength was one regiment of infantry, six squad-rons of cavalry and four guns. Our force then occupied Tsangshin, about 19 miles west of Yngpan. 
