White Plains, N. Y., Nov. 23.—An effort to shift the Stillman divorce hearings to Canada will be made in Poughkeepsie on next Saturday. Yesterday John E. Mack, guardian of Buy Stillman, whose paternity has been attacked by James A. Stillman, New York banker, arrived here to confer with the counsel for Mrs. Anne U. Stillman, defendant.

Mrs. Stillman's counsel will apply to supreme court justice Merchauch for a commission to examine witnesses in Montreal, Three Rivers and other places across the border. Mr. Mack will join in the motion.

Mr. Mack announced that while the Canadian testimony was being taken hearings would be continued next week before Referee Gleason in Poughkeepsie.

#### TRURO MAN GETS ONE AT OLD GLORY SALE OF HORSES

New York, Nov. 23.—(Canadian Press).—Canadian buyers, were in evidence at the opening of the annual Old Glory Sales at Squadron A. Armoury, P. Vandeleo of Montreal was the largest individual Canadian buyer at the opening day, picking up four bargains. The largest price paid yesterday was \$9,000 for Sybil Frisco, b. f. 1920, by San Francisco, dam Sybil Worthy, by Asworbly. The purchaser was the Brook Farm, Chester, N. Y.

Peter Worthy, 219½, b. c. 1919, by Peter Worthy, dam Petronella W. by Petarist, brought the next highest figure, \$3,100, going to D. H. Young, Holyoke, Mass.

Most of the first day's offerings were young stock.

Other Canadian buyers yesterday included Cocho Bay, 219½, blk. g. 1919, by Walter Cocho, dam Mary Morgan, by Morgan Pilot, Wm. McManus, Truro, N. S., \$250.

#### TO HONOR WAR DEAD.

Appropriate Headstones for Soldiers and Sailors.

Vancouver, Nov. 23.—Devotion and respect has been completed for the honoring of dead soldiers and sailors with appropriate headstones in British Columbia and Alberta. These two provinces are said to be the first to receive action in a Dominion-wide movement, and the other provinces will receive attention later.

Under official authority from the Department of Militia and Defence, and the Imperial War Graves Commission, Ottawa, orders have been placed here for an immediate minimum of five hundred headstones, with the understanding that more than five hundred other grave materials will be placed when the first order is completed.

The stone will come from quarries at Granite Island, near Vancouver. Many of the stones will be laid out this year. The design is of simple beauty. Two feet six inches high and one foot three inches wide, each stone will have at the top a circular Maple Leaf and the name of the deceased, with a brief record of his services and death.

#### ORIENTALS IN SCHOOLS.

There are nearly 1,000 Japanese and Chinese pupils attending the Vancouver public schools, according to statistics recently given out. There are 469 Chinese and 501 Japanese. These students are from one to seven years older than the other members of their classes. In the majority of cases, school principals do not consider the Orientals a hindrance to other pupils.

#### SCHOOL BOY BIES OF RABIES.

Has Been Bitten by Stray Dog Six Weeks Ago.

Bitten by a stray dog six weeks ago, Henry Russell, thirteen years old, a school boy, of New York, died in Bellevue Hospital of rabies. Little was thought of the boy's injury when he received it, but two days ago his head began to droop and he showed signs of the disease. His mother hurried him to Bellevue Hospital where efforts to save him failed.

Dr. Benjamin Schwartz, assistant medical examiner, performed an autopsy on the body and confirmed the belief that rabies caused the boy's death. For scientific purposes Chief Medical Examiner Charles Norris purposes to have a microscopic examination of the dead boy's internal organs.

**Races Return \$10,352,000.**  
Montreal, Nov. 23.—Receipts of the pari-mutuel machines in the 112 days of thoroughbred racing this year in this province totaled \$10,352,000, according to figures furnished by Francis H. Dun, government inspector.

Receipts on each of the mile tracks were about \$2,000,000. Belmorier Park, a half mile course, handled \$1,200,000, and on the other half-mile courses the receipts were from \$600,000 to \$800,000.

#### 55,184 FARMS.

Manitoba's Agricultural Census Shows Increases.

Winnipeg, Nov. 23.—Marking an increase of more than 18 per cent. in the last five years, the 1921 census of crop acreage and numbers of livestock in Manitoba, taken by the Manitoba department of agriculture, shows 55,184 farms in the province. The figures announced by the department are made on the basis of 15,271 farms during the month of June. The total acreage was 7,463,735, of which 3,501,217 was in wheat and 2,226,276 in oats. The number of live stock and poultry kept this year totals \$346,227. Of these more than 3,000,000 were hens.
