

**ACTION OF FACTORIES OF NORTH FRANCE**

Production has been reduced one half the factories of the zone where the outbreak of the war industry and where for four years, of this year, about thirteen per cent at work only a month ago. The Associated Press, who are reporting the war zone under a special arrangement of the government, showed in this report 80,000 plants employ 3,000 workers, were taxed by government or badly disorganized.

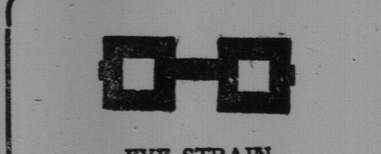
