directed to raise their respective share of the above amount and pay to the Treasurer.

LXIV. We appoint John R. Harris and William Harris a Committee on printing and direct that 900 copies of the Yearly Meeting's Minutes be printed. Also 500 copies of the address to our scattered members.

LXV. We direct the Clerk to secure reduced railway fares for those who may desire to attend our next Yearly Meeting.

LXVI. A memorial from the Friends' Anti-Vivi-Section Society of London Yearly Meeting has been read. We commend it to the consideration of Friends.

LXVII. The Committee on Correspondence presented the following report, together with a draft of an epistle, and a letter to be sent to our missionary, Alma G. Dale, and one to our scattered members in Western Canada. We direct the Clerk to prepare, sign and forward copies to their respective places.

To Canada Yearly Meeting:

We do not find any thing requiring special mention this year in any of the Epistles. We have therefore prepared a draft of one Epistle to all the Yearly Meetings, which we submit with a draft of letter to be sent to Alma G. Dale, and one to our scattered members in Western Canada.
