

MEDICAL REPORT

On behalf of the Medical Staff of this institution, I beg to submit our annual report, and as on former occasions it is gratifying to say that during the last year no sickness of a serious nature has occurred. During the whole of the recent severe winter, while other institutions both public and private were severely afflicted with contagious and infectious diseases, and outbreaks of deadly diphtheria, this home with its 200 inmates was happily free from such dire visitations.

This happy condition is due to the tact and care of Miss Wheelwright and associated workers in charge of the institution, and more especially to the untiring attention and watchfulness of the board of Directresses. We commend to the thoughtful and Christian public the noble efforts of these ladies, and point with pride to their successful record for so many years.

But one death occurred during the year from croup. We gratefully acknowledge the uniform courtesy and support of the Board and cheerfully give our assistance in the position to which we are appointed.
