Maple trees ought not to be tapped till they are 15 inches in diameter, and then they do not show any signs of decay for a long series of years. They should be tapped with a half inch augur, or bit in from four to eight places. A large tree with eight spouts will yield about 8 pounds of sugar. It is essential that all vessels used, buckets, barrels, and kettles, should be strictly clean. A cord of wood will boil about 180 pounds of sugar. Maple sugar is often whitened by being drained, a wet cloth being placed on top of the mass and opportunity given for the syrup to drain away. This detracts from its peculiar flavour.
