

PRIZES AND SCHOLARSHIPS FOR 1897-98.

The Adelaide L. Dicklow Prize of \$25.00, given annually to that member of the Fourth Year who, in the Third and Fourth Years, proves most worthy.

The Alumnae Prize, given annually to that member of the Third Year who proves most worthy.

The Mrs. A. R. McMaster Prize of \$10, given annually to that member of the Second Year who proves most worthy.

The D. E. Thomson Prize, given annually to that member of the Class of 1900 who shows greatest proficiency in the department of English.

A special Annual Scholarship in Instrumental Music, of the value of \$105, is offered by the Musical Director, Mr. Vogt, the scholarship being open to competition to daughters of Baptist ministers. The Scholarship will be awarded to the candidate who, in the competition, evinces the highest order of musical talent and proficiency. Candidates shall notify the Principal, Miss Dicklow, on or before September 1st, of their intention of competing for the Scholarship. Due notice will then be given of the time and place of competition.
