## REGULATION

RESPECTING

## OPTIONAL SUBJECTS OF EXAMINATION.

Every Candidate is required to notify the Registrar, at the time of his transmitting his Certificates, of the optional subject or subjects in which he proposes to offer himself for examination.

## REGULATIONS RESPECTING TEXT-BOOKS.

- Where a Text-Book in any subject is SUGGESTED OF RE-COMMENDED, and not actually PRESCRIBED, the intention is merely to indicate the nature and extent of the knowledge of the subject expected from Candidates.
- 2. Where several Text-Books are in any subject suggest-ED, Candidates may use any one of them, or any group of them, as the case may be. But in all such cases the Candidates shall notify the Registrar at the time of transmitting their Certificates, of the Text-Book or Text-Books used by them; and the Registrar, in his notification to the Examiners in these subjects, shall give a list of all the books used by the several Candidates.
