LIVELY FIGHT AT P. E. ISLAND TORY CONVENTION

Ottawa, Dec. 20—The government has decided that civil servants shall not be allowed after school to take municipal offices as next year.

Experience has shown that many civil servants in cities like Ottawa neglect their office duties in order to dabble in municipal politics.

Heads of departments have made repeated protests against the practice, and it has been finally decided to pass an order-in-council prohibiting government employees to run for municipal office.

The prohibition will take effect after the coming municipal elections are over.

Owing to the fact that a number of civil servants in Ottawa and elsewhere have already announced their candidacy this month, and the campaign is already well started, it was felt that the order should not be enforced at once.

However, it was passed now with a view to giving fair warning for next year.

The order applies to all government employees drawing salaries of over \$500 per year.
