Brutally murdered in his bedroom and s body hauled through the street in old wheelbarrow, to be dumped in alley—that was the fate of James Sloane, a pioneer merchant and forner member of the Sloane-Paine com-pany. The body of Mr. Sloane was found n an alley near Stevens street, near the ane home on Sixth avenue, about 6 clock this morning by a woman. She mptly telephoned to the police staon. The body showed at once that a owardly murder had been committed. here were numberless gashes on the ead, which appeared as though they ad been inflicted with a hatchet.

One of the gashes extended almost rom ear to ear while there were a large imber of three cornered wounds on ne skull. The murderer evidently struck dozen or more blows.

After killing the merchant the mur-
