

BILL.

An Act to consolidate the Laws relative to the powers and duties of the Trinity House of Quebec, and for other purposes.

WHEREAS the provisions of Acts and Ordinances now in force, relative to the powers and duties of the Trinity House of Quebec, to Pilots and Pilotage in and below the Harbour of Quebec, to the fund for decayed Pilots, their widows and children, and to other matters therein mentioned, have become obscure by repeated amendments; And whereas experience hath shewn that they are insufficient for the purposes for which they were framed, and it is therefore expedient to repeal them, and to amend and consolidate the provisions therein contained, and to enact other provisions; Be it therefore enacted, &c.

Preamble.

And it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, as follows;

1st. The Act of the Parliament of the Province of Lower Canada, passed in the forty-fifth year of the Reign of King George the Third, intituled: "*An Act for the better regulation of Pilots and Shipping in the Port of Quebec, and in the Harbours of Quebec and Montreal, and for improving the Navigation of the River St. Lawrence, and for establishing a Fund for decayed Pilots, their Widows and Children,*" is repealed.
