I just can't see why we can't have open rooms if a majority of the girls want it.



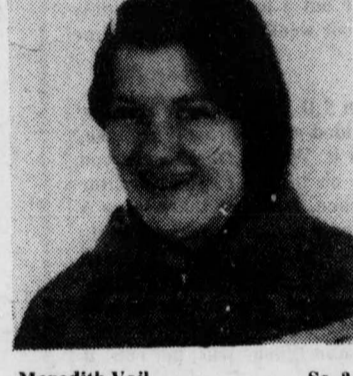
Carol Jones For. 2
