

Dublin 14 June 1828

Sir

My departure being necessarily delayed for two or three days, I beg to apprise you of it, to prevent your being put to any inconvenience by expecting me sooner than I shall arrive at York. The Instructions of the Commander of the Forces will render it necessary for me to pass a day or two at that place, before I go on to Niagara. I leave this on the 17th Inst. —
