

Montreal 11<sup>th</sup> July 1800

My Dear Sir,

I owe you my thanks for your last friendly letter of the 7<sup>th</sup>. The Abstracts of Pay, and the Accounts accompanying them which you returned to me, were sent into me by my son from La Chine, where he resides, only in time to put my name to them <sup>before the departure of the Post,</sup> without examination, or I would have observed the several Mistakes, as to the Pay, and Pensions of Lieut. Colonel De Chambault, La Motte, Destimantille, &c. &c. and have detected, and corrected them - but there are several Persons named in Mr. Myland's Certified Copy of the Establishment of Lower Canada that were never entered on our Pay List, particularly the Missionaries, however, agreeably to your desire they are now included, but I have adhered to the Instructions signified to me in your letter of the 12<sup>th</sup> of May, as far as to the broken period from the 1<sup>st</sup> May, to the 24<sup>th</sup> of June, otherwise
