I have the honor
to forward report with diary
attached for month just ended.

We have been employed
during the month, looking after
Indians planting roots, which
have all been put in very careful.

It has been very dry (no
rain) and the crops are not look-
ing very prosperous.

New root houses will be
required, as the old one is a very
poor one, and is too close to the river
bank, should the water rise as gen-
erally does it will be washed away
and there is no timber here sufficient
to construct a new one.

This reserve has been visited
by Mrs McQuinn on the 2nd, and also
by your self, frequently during
the month.
