

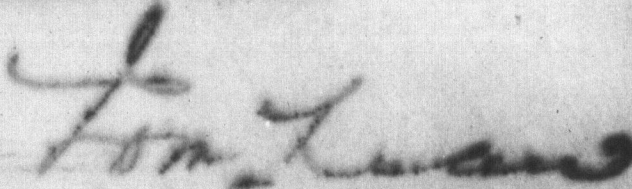

Sir,--

In reply to your letter of the 9th instant, No. 91074 T & M, I beg to inform you that the Indian reserve situated in the locality to which you refer was surveyed long before the Interior Department surveys of townships had reached there, and these, in fact, have not yet reached that reserve. It would appear, however, that Section No. 29, Tp. 51, R. 27, West of the 2nd Meridian is included within the limits of Indian reserve No. 101, Chief Wm. Twatt, and small strips off the southerly ends of Sections 35 and 36, Tp. 51, R. 1, West of the 3rd Meridian, may be included within the limits of the same reserve.
