



Referring to your letter of the 28th April, I beg to transmit herewith for action thereon copy of official letter of the 8th April, which the Department addressed to Mr. McGibbon at Port Arthur on the subject of placing insurance on the buildings therein mentioned on the Fort William Reserve. You should take up the question of necessary repairs to the Indian houses therein referred to with a view to having policies written for the insurance. It will be necessary for you to submit a full estimate of the cost with regard to each house, but you should not incur any expenditure without authority from the Department.
