
Ottawa, February 13th., 1917.

I beg to transmit herewith cheque No. 1387 for \$156.00 in full settlement of the account from the St. Joseph's Hospital at La Tuque for maintenance and care, etc., of Indian patients in the said institution from the 2nd August 1916 to the 26th December last. With respect to the amount at which payment has been made, I beg to say that the charges for medicines have been disallowed. I have also to point out that there was a charge of \$1.00 in the case of Elsie Boucher, who was only in the institution twelve not thirteen days as charged for. Payment for twelve days has been made.
