

Ottawa, March 17, 1919.

Rev. Sir,-

I have to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 12th instant in regard to the clothing, etc., which the Militia Department has for disposal, and enclosing a list of the articles which you are in need of and which will be useful to you.

In reply I beg to say that I am sending you herewith a list of surplus stores which the Militia Department has for disposal, together with the prices at which these articles can be sold. The Department is advised that all these articles, with the exception of the bell tents, are new goods, and that the latter are in good condition. The prices are strictly confidential.

Kindly advise the Department as soon as possible whether you wish to obtain any of the articles at the prices quoted and, if so, state the quantity of each.

The Department will pay the account for any of the supplies you purchase and the amount will be deducted in quarterly instalments to suit you from the per capita grant due the Fort Frances Boarding School for the next fiscal year.
