
Ottawa, June 19th., 1919.

Sir,-

In view of the report in your letter of the 16th instant, I beg to say that you may furnish necessary relief to Frank Sark and his family, which assistance is required consequent upon the fact that Sark is tubercular and unable to work. I have to inform you however that you should lose no time in reporting the amount of assistance which will be required weekly in this case.

Accounts for assistance afforded Sark should be marked with the word "Tuberculosis" before being sent to the Department.
