

Fifth Witness for Prosecution

Christinus Leonardus Banderij 11t Sanstraat 130
 Nijmegen Holland sworn states:

I live with my father and mother and brother.

On 14 Feb 45 there were two soldiers bulletted in
 our home one was Sgt Carlouke and a 659
 but I do not know his name, at 1930 hrs
 someone rang the door bell and my father
 opened the door, and the soldier came in and
 went up stairs and when the soldier was
 going up stairs I told him in Eng that
 Sgt Carlouke was out, I went up stairs
 to, and the soldier asked me for a pencil,
 I went down stairs to get a pencil, when I was
 down stairs I heard a noise similar to a bullet
 coming into contact with a hard object, I went
 up stairs with the pencil, the soldier was coming
 down stairs and asked me for a sheet of paper
 to write a message to the Sgt and the soldier
 asked me when the Sgt would be back I told
 him that the Sgt had told me he would be
 back 2230 hrs. I recognize that soldier to-day

The witness points to Gnr Sulliman as
 the soldier referred to in his statement.

The soldier then gave me the pencil back
 and left the house taking the piece of paper
 with him, and he told me he would
 be back at 2230 hrs when the Sgt would
 be there.
