the new Arts building, now used as the Theological Hall. The classes in Arts and Theology were then transferred to this new and commodious structure; and the Medical College, grown stronger and more confident in its own ability after its strenuous trials, returned, for the last time we hope, to its former home on the campus. There may it live and flourish in the years to come, growing stronger in its courses of instruction, stronger in the number of its students, and stronger in its influence throughout the country in which lie its opportunities.
