HIS EXCELLENCY

ROBERT PRESCOTT, Esquire, GOVERNOR.

‘ **A**T the Provincial Parliament, begun and holden at Quebec, the twenty-  
‘ fourth day of January, *Anno Domini*, one thousand seven hundred  
‘ and ninety-seven, in the thirty-seventh year of Our Sovereign Lord,  
‘ GEORGE the Third, by the Grace of GOD, of *Great Britain, France* and  
‘ *Ireland*, KING, Defender of the Faith, &c.

‘ And from thence continued by several Prorogations to the twenty-eighth  
‘ day of March, one thousand seven hundred and ninety-nine, being the third  
‘ Session of the second Provincial Parliament of Lower Canada.”
