⁶ **A** T the Provincial Parliament, begun and holden at Quebec, the twentyfourth day of January, Anno Domini, one thousand seven hundred and ninety-seven, in the thirty-seventh year of Our Sovereign Lord, GEORGE the Third, by the Grace of GOD, of Great Britain, France and Ireland, KING, Defender of the Faith, &c.

'And from thence continued by several Prorogations to the twenty-eighth 'day of March, one thousand seven hundred and ninety-nine, being the third 'Session of the second Provincial Parliament of Lower Canada."

CAP. I.

AN ACT further to continue for a limited time, an Act passed in the thirty-third year of His Majesty's Reign, intituled, "An Act to provide "Returning Officers for Knights, Citizens and Eurgesses to serve in "Assembly." [Expired.]

CAP.II.

AN ACT further to continue an Act passed in the thirty-sixth year of His Majesty's Reign, intituled "An Act for making a temporary "Provision for the Regulation of Trade, between this Province and the "United States of America, by Land or Inland Navigation."
