fand pounds currency, out of any money now remaining, or which may hereafter come into the hands of the Receiver General of the Province, in virtue of any Act or Acts of the Legislature, and not appropriated by Law, should be applied towards that purpose.

Resolved, That it is the opinion of this Committee, that tome regulations are necessary and requisite for the Pilotage of Scows and Rasts through the rapids from Chateanguay to Montreal.

On motion of Mr. M'Gill, seconded by Mr. Mondelet,

Ordered, That the question of concurrence be now severally put on the said resolutions.

Accordingly the faid resolutions were again severally read, and the question being seperately put upon each, they were severally agreed unto by the House.
