

PROCLAMATION.

James Crowdy, (L. S.)

By His Honor James Crowdy, Esquire, Administrator of the Government of the Island of Newfoundland and its Dependencies.

WHEREAS the GENERAL ASSEMBLY of this Island stands Prorogued until Thurs-DAY the Twenty-fourth day of July instant: And whereas I think fit further to Prorogue the said General Assembly until Thursday the Eighteenth day of September next ensuing:

I do, therefore, by this my Proclamation, further Prorogue the said GENERAL ASSEMBLY until THURSDAY the *Eighteenth* day of *September* next. Of which all persons concerned are required and commanded to take due notice and govern themselves accordingly.

GIVEN under my Hand and Seal at St. John's, in the aforesaid Island, the Fifteenth day of July, One Thousand Eight Hundred and Fifty-one, and in the Fifteenth Year of Her Majesty's Reign.
