HERSHEY GIVES \$60,000,000 TRUST FUND FOR ORPHANS

Milton S. Hershey, multi-millionaire chocolate manufacturer, founder of the town of Hershey, near Harrisburg, Pa., has placed his entire wealth, conservatively estimated at \$60,000,000, in trust for the Hershey Industrial School, which he founded in 1909. This is now the largest school of its kind in America, next to Girard College. The school is open first to orphans born in Dauphin, Lebanon and Lancaster counties, Pa., second to those born elsewhere in Pennsylvania, and third to those born elsewhere in the United States.


