DIRECTIONS FOR MAKING BREAD:

To one quart of milk or water add two-thirds of a teacupful of yeast; add flour to the thickness of batter, and let it rise over night; then add flour enough to kneed softly twenty minutes, or until it will not cling to the board, as it requires much more kneeding than Winter Wheat Flour. Let it rise in the pan, then make into small loaves, and let it rise again. Bake in a moderate over. Be sure and not let it stand in the oven after it is done, and we will promise you a most beautiful, sweet, white bread. This flour will work very much better by thoroughly drying it out. Let it set on the back of the stove, or some other warm place, twenty-four hours, and you will be surprised at the difference it will make in either bread or cake. Some good cooks keep a lot of dried out flour on hand all the time and regard it a great secret.

DIRECTIONS FOR MAKING THE BEST YEAST: Boll a handful of hops in two quarts of water ten injuntes. Then strain, and to the liquor add six good-siz grated potatoes, one cup of sugar and one tablespoonful of salt. Let it simmer one half hour; when lukewar add one cup of good yeast, and let it rise.
