



Under the provisions of the Measures Act, 1914, the Governor in Council is pleased to order that the Regulations shall come into force and from the 15th day of June 1917.

1. The port and harbor of St. John's shall be closed entirely to shipping at night on the 15th June instant and orders.

2. The Light at Cape Spear reduced in visibility, and the Fort Amherst and the Light of St. John's will be extinguished.

3. Measures shall be taken to clear the glare or upward street or other outdoor light City of St. John's shall be reduced to twenty-five per cent. of the normal. This Regulation will apply to Island, Conception Bay, etc.

4. No Light shall be in a building, shop, or residence in the City of St. John's, or in any settlement in the District of St. John's East or West, or in any settlement, upon the 15th June, or thereafter, which may be visible at sea, or which obscures that the glare or reflection upon the heavens is reduced to twenty-five per cent. of the normal. Side lights on cars, motor cycles, or vehicles shall not be of greater than five candle power.

7. It will be the duty of the Constabulary to enforce these Regulations and to see that all orders are carried out for their better observance forthwith carried out.

8. It shall be the duty of the Master of Marine and Fisheries that these Regulations are carried out on all ships in the harbor of St. John's, and all orders for their better observance shall be carried out.

9. Every person convicted of an offence under these Rules shall be liable before a Stipendiary Magistrate of the Peace, or a Justice of the Peace, to a penalty not exceeding \$100 in default of payment, or to imprisonment not exceeding three months.
