Dear Sir.—As a citizen I would rather praise the Municipal Council lanation is due the public as to why r streets and lanes are smothered ith dust when 75 per cent. of the application of tarvia as in previous years. Although it is nearly the midlle of July no effort has been made to nence this work and the streets are not even prepared for the tar. Practically all of the streets need some slight repairs and even Military Road and LeMarchant Road, the chief roadway on the Higher Levels, is covered with ridges and pot holes. There is no reasonable argument as to why this work should be delayed until half the summer had passed. Although the spring was cold, we have had dozens of fine warm days since April when this work could have been done, and we have just experienced about two weeks of suitable warm weather. There is certainly need for a shake up either in the Council or among the staff. We are paying enough taxes to receive decent living conditions, and if those in charge of this work are not prepared to act in an efficient manner they should make room for those who will. The use of tarvia on the level streets makes a permanent and clean road for a season, and thin oil which does not stick or harden could be imported and used on the hills and so keep the dust down without being slippery for horses. No doubt tarvia would be just as good for sidewalks as it is
