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Educational discussions will be continued, notably that introduced by Professor Palmer, of Harvard, in the November number.

The Moral Aspects of Literary Topics will be considered in special papers.

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The Editorial and other departments will be conducted as heretofore, with increased attention to Book Reviews.

N.B.—After Jan. 1, 1886, the price of the Review will be \$4.00. Until that date subscriptions will be received at the present rate, \$3.00, from old and new subscribers. Postal Notes and Money are at the risk of the sender, and therefore remittances should be made by money-order, draft, or registered letter to

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the parts of the British Empire with each other.

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
