Arranged attendance by ABC Board of Directors at roundtable meeting and hospitality functions on behalf of Cdn delegates. Attended roundtable and ABC hospitality functions, staffed information booth and reported on positive results from Cdn govt and industry participation in this advanced medical technology and healthcare sector. Organized US speakers and made presentations in Cdn Export Assn seminars across Canada on US fed govt. Coordinated education, hospitality, and booth presence for Canadian participants in Federal Office Systems Expo 9/3/89. Participation as Embassy observer at US/Cda bilateral discussions on FTA tariff reduction acceleration. On short notice, coordinated three city visit program for Otawa-based architectural consultants; calls were designed to lay groundwork for subsequent arch services mission from Cda in April. Five TID speaking engagements accepted in territory. Embassy's Commercial Section relocated to new facilities which resulted in short-term disruption of program operations.
