Section I

Route to be operated by the designated airline of Canada:

Notes:

- Beyond points named by Canada shall be limited to:
Manila, Kuala Lumpur, Singapore and Bombay. The fourth beyond point shall be available for passenger/combination services when the Korean designated airline begins service to Montreal.
- All-cargo services may be operated in both directions via the Pacific and/or in an easterly direction as part of an around the world service. Points named for all-cargo services may be different from those named for passenger/combination services and shall not exceed four at any one time.
- Traffic in-transit may be carried through Seoul provided it is carried on the same flight. Own stop-over traffic is permitted.
- Unless otherwise agreed in accordance with the provisions of Article 9, capacity for passenger/combination services shall not exceed four flights weekly in each direction,
