5.50 p.m. The Queen and The Duke of Edinburgh leave the Legislative Building and are conducted by Premier Bennett to the reviewing stand in front of the Legislative Buildings on Belleville Street.

6.00 p.m. March past by Royal Canadian Navy, Canadian Army and Royal Canadian Air Force. (Parade Commander—Captain (L) J. C. Gray, C.D., R.C.N.)

Her Majesty takes the Salute.

6.15 p.m. The Queen and The Duke of Edinburgh leave reviewing stand.

The Premier of British Columbia and Mrs. Bennett take leave.

The Queen and The Duke of Edinburgh enter their automobile to return to Government House.
