This exchange program is an IAS program and is based on close cooperation between the Institut für Photogrammetrie und Ingenieurvermessung and the Department of Surveying Engineering (which recently has been renamed as the Department of Geodesy and Geomatics). Thus, the exchange is restricted to students from these departments only. As an IAS program, the exchange is basically a unilateral one, only a few Canadian students have come to Hanover and not on a regular basis. Within the program, up to three German stu-

dents go to New Brunswick for the duration of one academic year. The participants are expected to have a good to excellent academic record and to have Second year standing ("Vordiplom"). Although the TOEFL Test is not required, students interested in the exchange should have a decent knowledge of English (which would equal a score of at least 550 points in the TOEFL Test).

The students are screened and selected by the department. The program covers a tuition waiver, a contribution to travel expenses and a monthly allowance of about DM 600 for the duration of eight months.

Students remain enrolled at their home university but usually receive leave status.
