Even while we are beginning to see the first fruits of nuclear power for peaceful uses stocks of thermonuclear armaments are building up and world tensions are not diminishing. We must hasten to solve our ancient problems of living together if we are to survive. We are now at last faced with the desperate alternative of one world or none.
