

the Informal Gathering of World Leaders to which representatives of governments and international institutions are invited. The Davos Symposium 1983 brought together over 500 chief executive officers and public leaders of the highest level from 52 countries. Six Prime Ministers, seventeen Ministers of Economy and Finance, and nearly all the heads of international and regional organizations of economic importance attended, taking part in discussions with the businessmen present at the Symposium and among themselves at the Informal Gathering of World Leaders on Global Economic Issues. An attendance of approximately 600 chief executive officers, largely from Western Europe but with significant representation from other areas is assured for next January's meeting.
