investigation ever undertaken into major lake pollution, Canada and the United States entered into the Great Lakes Water Quality Agreement in 1972 to restore the Lakes' quality by funding treatment plants and research applications within the next few years.

The Canada Water Act provides for water programs on the federal-provincial front. We have now completed comprehensive development plans jointly with the provinces for the Qu'Appelle, Okanagan and Saint John basins. Newer activities include the 1973 agreement with Ontario to jointly undertake a \$0.7 million Great Lakes shore

damage survey, the 1974 agreement with Alberta and Saskatchewan to cost-share a \$2 million submerged weir to restore water levels in the Peace-Athabasca delta, and a subsequent agreement with Saskatchewan and Manotoba to cost share a \$1.1 million comprehensive investigation of the Souris basin.
