GOVERNMENT EXPENDITURES RESTRAINT ACT, 1993 NO. 2

ALLOCATION OF TIME TO CONSIDER SECOND READING OF BILL C-113

Hon. Charles Mayer (Minister of Agriculture): Madam Speaker, pursuant to Standing Order 78(3), I move:

That in relation to Bill C-113, an act to provide for government expenditure restraint, not more than one further sitting day shall be allotted to the consideration of second reading stage of the bill; and

That 15 minutes before the expiry of the time provided for Government Orders on the day allotted to the second reading stage consideration of the said bill, any proceedings before the House shall be interrupted, if required, for the purpose of this order and, in turn, every question necessary to dispose of the second reading stage of the bill shall be put forthwith and successively, without further debate or amendment.
